Homepage interface provide user several options such as:


- 1. Log in




Lecturer's View

Interface - Profile




- This view can be access by clicking the option appear when hovering at the user's image.

Interface - Dashboard




- Showing courses that the lecturer currently teach for that semester.

- To view the content of the course, just click to the course's name.




- This is where most


Blended Status

All courses in the system must achieve "BLENDED" status to enables the course to be conducted for blended learning.




Course Content

- This is where all the slides, assignment and other **teaching materials** are placed.
- Only the lecturers of the course can manage the content placement.
- To upload a new content, user must click on the green "Turn Editing On" button.




Course Content

- The green button changed color to red button when clicked.
- In this mode, the order of the content can be change freely and the design is up to the creativity of the lecturer.
- "Add an activity or resource" link the function to add new content.




Add Activity/Resource

- This is the list of activities and resources that can be added into the course.
- Each activities and resources have its **own unique functions**. For example, Questionnaire can accommodate lecturer to construct a multiple answer questions.
- But they also shared some common function such as Access Restriction







Add Activity / Resource

Through this option, lecturers can fulfil the minimum requirement of Blended Learning.

Resource


- These items are in the **Resource category**:

- These items are in the Activities category :
 - Chat, Choice, Database, Feedback, Forum, Glossary, Lesson, Questionnaire, Survey, Wiki & Group Choice


Assessments

- These items are in the Assessments category :
 - Quiz, Assignment, Workshop, Turnitin




Add a Resource

- Resource is a teaching material such as notes, presentation slides and online videos, as a medium for student to get the knowledge.
- eLearning system also have a function to embed video or animated images into the system so that the student can just view the content inside
- The item uploaded will become link for the student to download.




Add an Activity

- An Activity is a type of teaching module that enable interactions between lecturer and students.
- For example, a **Chat** is a module for the lecturer and students have a **real time** discussion.



Add an Assessment

- Assessments are the module for the lecturer to grade the students
- Quizzes may be used
 - As course exams
 - As mini tests at the end of a topic
 - As exam practice
 - To deliver immediate feedback about performance
 - For self-assessment




Administration Block

- This is the section that can be used to set grading marks, edit course settings, view list of enrolled students and many other settings.
- eLearning system have a Course Participation report that can help in monitoring students activity.

Student's View

Interface - Profile



- Basically the same as the lecturer's profile
- User details section shows the user's information such as name & country that editable.
- Course details section shows the list of courses the user's teach

Interface - Dashboard



- Showing courses that have been taken by the students.
- Can be access through "Main" tab.
- The layout is separated into Blocks.
 - Calendar
 - Upcoming Events



- This can be interpreted as a restricted version of lecturer's display.
- While the lecturer can view all the students participation, the student can only view their own participation



- Students cannot control the administration settings, thus can only view courses, download notes and participate into quizzes of enrolled courses.
- Students also can upload assignment through eLearning but depending to the task set on the assignment.


Person in -charge

- The head of eLearning Coordinator , stationed at Centre for Academic Development (Pusat Pembangunan Akademik (PPA))and IT Officer from Centre for Communication and Information Technology (Pusat Teknologi Maklumat & Komunikasi (PTMK))have the all-access to the system.
- These are the person that plays a role in managing and troubleshooting the system, but a report need to come-in either directly from the user or through the supporting personnels.

Supporting personnel

- Each Faculty in UPNM have appointed an elearning Coordinator to manage the system in tandem with in -charge personnel from PPA and PTMK.
- They have been given extra access to **eLearning Reporting System**, which is a system that tabulated and visualize the usage statistics of eLearning.

Interface – eLearning Reporting System



- The statistics are visualized the usage per month of that specific year.
- Each faculty's statistics can be seen from this reporting system.
